Even though breast cancer was no stranger to my family, I never thought I would be dealing with the same battle. Two years prior to my diagnosis, two of my three sisters were treated for breast cancer. It was a rude awakening when I too was told I had early stage ductal carcinoma.

Even with all the support my family and sisters offered, the knowledge I gleaned from their experiences, and all the research and preparations I made, I found myself struggling with anxiety and fear right before my surgery.

Neither of my sisters had the exact micro surgery I was going to be having, leaving me with a lot of questions.


I'm normally someone who tackles a problem head on. If there's a problem, solve it; if something is broken, fix

it. But processing and coping with a breast cancer diagnosis, and the many treatment decisions needing to be made is an entirely different beast.

I was searching for something to help ease my fears. I decided to dig through the pages and folders and binders of information that I had received and came upon the ABCD brochure. I thought, "It can't hurt to give it a try." If they can connect me with someone that has been through the exact micro surgery I was having and the same cancer, it's worth a shot.

ABCD (Nancy Huck, Helpline Mentor) was able to find that someone for me. That simple call to the Helpline connected me to my first Match Mentor, Therese Quinn. She helped calm my nerves, answered all the questions that only someone who





has been through cancer and my specific surgery could answer. She was there before and after my surgery, to let me vent and listened to all the things that I knew she could relate to. I knew I could call her if I needed anything: knowing that was priceless.

When I was dealing with some healing issues that Therese didn't have experience with, I reached out to ABCD to see if there was someone else they could link me with to help me through my healing process. Not only did the match specialist find a Mentor that dealt with my very specific healing issues (Thank you, Jennifer Utter), they also found me another Mentor when I needed support through Phase 2 of the specific reconstructive surgery I had chosen (Thank you, Ellen Benson).

All three ladies were exactly what I needed at the time I needed them. I didn't have to set up an appointment, fulfill another deductible, or sit in a waiting room with six drain tubes hanging from my body feeling like I was going to pass out. They were a text, phone call, or email away. They felt the raw emotion of the journey only someone who has been diagnosed with breast cancer can connect with.

I am happy to say I have been cancer free since November 26th, 2014. **ABCD** and my Mentors were instrumental in my treatment and my recovery from breast cancer. And for that, I will be forever grateful.

I am so grateful that at the end of 2015
I decided I wanted to give back to the
organization that helped me. I signed

up for ABCD'S Mentor Training program and headed to Illinois for two days of education and training to become a Mentor to someone in her time of need. By the end of the two days I found myself thinking... "Wow, ABCD is really onto something here." I knew how important my Mentors were to me, but to feel the energy from the breast cancer survivors in the room who also wanted to voluntarily help those in need was really special.

ABCD is an organization that speaks to how I feel our world should be. By giving to others selflessly, we foster the desire to give selflessly in return. I look forward to the day when I get my first call on the Helpline or I am matched with my first person and I too can say with a soft ear and warm heart, I understand...

Melodie was driven by her strong commitment to helping all those dealing with breast cancer. She worked tirelessly to assure everyone dealing with breast cancer had access to FREE, personalized support. She believed with all her heart that no one should go through breast cancer alone.

Melodie was 49 when she launched ABCD: After Breast Cancer Diagnosis and only 59 when she lost her battle with breast cancer. Her dedication to ABCD and her belief in the power of one-to-one were second only to her grace and her everlasting spirit.
